



During 2016 – 2017 our agency provided donations to communities in Armenia, Burundi, Moldova, Ghana and Uganda. Many of these donations were delivered by our International Manager, Allie Smith. These have included the provision of food for hungry children, clothing, and a few toys. The support of our community positions us to respond to the call of those in need. 


